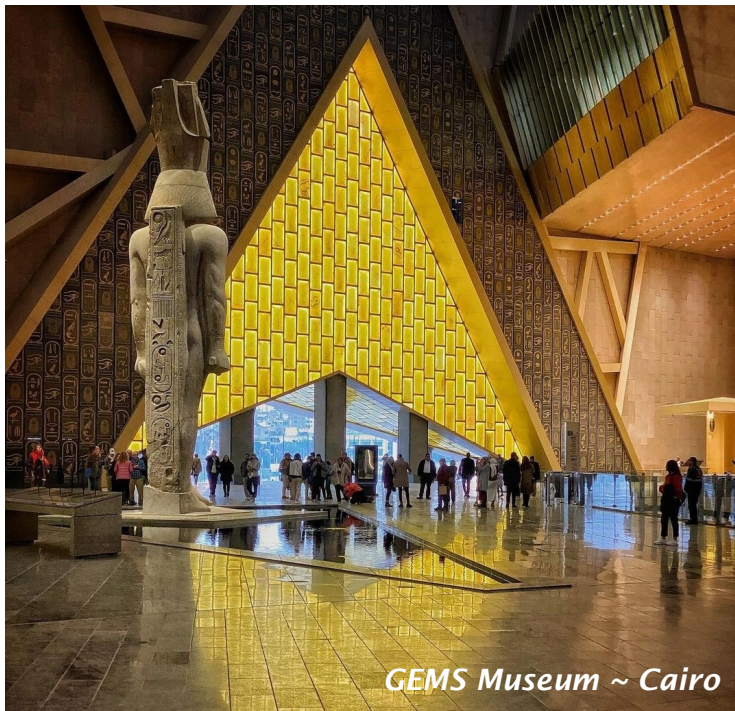

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

ATLANTA/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

MONDAY, NOV 10

Begin your exciting journey as you depart from Atlanta on board your overnight transatlantic flight to Egypt.

ARRIVE CAIRO

TUESDAY, NOV 11

Arrive in Cairo late this evening and transfer to your hotel. Your exciting journey through the wonders of Egypt begins. (D)

CAIRO

WEDNESDAY, NOV 12

Travel to Giza to view the Great Pyramids and the Sphinx, sole survivors of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, housing the magnificent treasures of Tut-Ankh-Ahmon. Continue to the newly opened GEMS Museum which houses the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. Afterwards proceed to the Citadel Fortress erected by Salah-ed-Din in the 12th Century. See the Alabaster Mosque and the Sultan Hassan Mosque, and stroll through the winding streets of Khan-el-Khalili Bazaar where artisans and merchants have traded for centuries. (B,D)

CAIRO/LUXOR

THURSDAY, NOV 13

This morning, fly to Luxor and then transfer to the pier for embarkation on your Nile cruise ship. After lunch, visit the Temples of Karnak and Luxor. Karnak Temple is the largest built by the ancient Egyptians. See the Hypostyle Hall, the Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut and the Festival Hall of Tuthmosis III. Continue to Luxor Temple, built by Amenophis III for Amun, his wife, Mut, and their son Khonsu. See the fine wall reliefs depicting the daily lives of the pharaohs. (B,L,D)

LUXOR/EDFU

FRIDAY, NOV 14

This morning you will cross the Nile to the West Bank and Thebes, the burial ground of the great pharaohs of the New Kingdom. Drive past the famed Colossi of Memnon. The highlight of this visit is the Valley of the Kings. See the Tomb of Ramses IV with its varied wall paintings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Return to your cruise ship where you can relax or sun-

bathe on the upper deck as you depart Luxor and set sail "up the Nile" (southbound) to Esna. Then continue to Edfu where you will overnight on board. **(B,L,D)**

EDFU/KOM OMBO/ASWAN

SATURDAY, NOV 15

This morning, disembark in Edfu to visit the Temple of Horus, the falcon god, protector of the sun, and one of the best preserved in Egypt. Re-board your boat and sail on to Kom Ombo where you see the Ptolmaic Temple dedicated to the two gods, crocodile-headed Sobek and hawk-headed Haroeri. Sail on to Aswan. **(B,L,D)**

ASWAN

SUNDAY, NOV 16

This morning, visit the New High Dam, the largest land filled dam in the world. Also see the Unfinished Obelisk. Continue to the Greco-Roman temples of Philae, reconstructed stone by stone on the island of Agilkia. After lunch, board a felucca sailboat and cross one of the Nile's tributaries. Sail around Elephantine Island and see the Mausoleum of Agha Khan. Visit the Botanical Gardens on Kitchener Island then return to your ship. **(B,L,D)**

ASWAN/CAIRO

MONDAY, NOV 17

After breakfast this morning you will disembark your fabulous Nile cruise and transfer to the Aswan airport for your short flight back to Cairo and your hotel. **(B,D)**

CAIRO

TUESDAY, NOV 18

This morning, drive to Memphis, capital of the ancient kingdom. See the Alabaster Sphinx and the beautifully carved statue of Ramses II. Continue to Sakkara and the Step Pyramid of Zoser. **(B,D)**

CAIRO

WEDNESDAY, NOV 19

Enjoy a free day in Cairo to explore the city or to return to the Egyptian Museum on your own. **(B,D)**

CAIRO/ATLANTA

THURSDAY, NOV 20

Your exciting visit of Egypt is over as you board your return flight to Atlanta, arriving the same day. **(B)**
